

Religious Education (Highlights)2021-2022

Hygiene and Cleanliness

1. Teachers and students will be asked to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering the building. Hand sanitizers will be available in all classrooms.
2. Students need to be instructed that they should do their best to always cough or sneeze into a tissue or their elbow.

Masks and Social Distancing

1. Face Masks will be optional.
2. Bathrooms will be available for emergency use only, please encourage your child to use the bathroom before they come from home.

Parents

1. Parents will be allowed in the building on the first night of CCD to complete paperwork.
2. Parents will have to wait outside the school building at the time of dismissal. Teachers will walk each class to the door. Grade 2 will start dismissal at 7:15. Every 2 minutes there after another class will be released. Students will only leave through the front door, this is also for the protection and safety of the students.

Students

1. Students will not be allowed to drink directly from the bubbler, they should bring their own water bottle.
2. Non-essential school items should remain at home.
3. We ask that cell phones be left at home.
4. Students will not be sharing textbooks, materials, supplies.
5. No food is to be brought into the school building.
6. Absolutely NO students will be allowed in the gym prior or after CCD classes.

Screening

1. It is the responsibility of the parent to make certain a child is healthy and able to attend religious education. If a child is suspected to have a fever of 100.4 they will be have a temperature check using a contactless thermometer. Please do not send your child if they show any signs of a fever, stomach ailments, sore throat, a bad cough, difficulty breathing, headaches, etc.
