Total income was \$1727.00, and expenses was \$497.32 for profit of \$1229.68. We would like to thank Kwik-Trip on donating \$400 worth of food. **Charity (Disaster) Raffle:** You should have received your raffle tickets by now. Please buy or sell them. If you need more contact Julie at the church office. She can give you more tickets and you can also return the money and stubs of sold tickets to her. The 2020-21 raffle sold 122,926 tickets for \$614,630.00. Expenses including the prizes amounted to \$149,873,17. Amount given back to WI councils was \$302,663.28 to be placed in the council charity fund savings account. The State has \$165,719.56 to be given out to grant on council's request. Currently we are working on a request for some of that money to help the victims in the Stanley tornado. In the past year we have collected \$900 from the State fund because of three disaster fires and \$2000 for a young woman with cancer. From our local fund this past year we donated \$3500 to people in our area that had a disaster or large medical expenses. So please sell as many tickets as you can for there is a lot of needs out there in our area.
